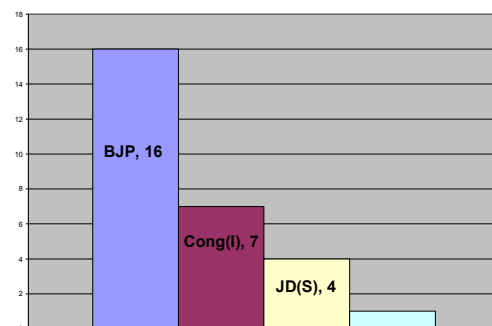
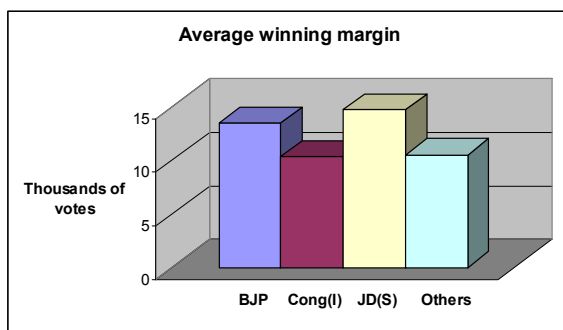


## Parliament Election -2009 Forecast for Karnataka

**media.syndicate** has come out with preliminary forecast of results of forthcoming parliament elections. Analysis has predicted minimum of 12 seats for BJP, 7 for Cong (I) and four for Third Front (JD-S). The numbers could jump to 16 for BJP, 12 for Cong (I) and 5 for Third Front. Congress(I) is expected to win Chikkodi, Bijapur, Gulbarga, Raichur, Bidar, Dharwad, Dakshina Kannada, Chitradurga, Mysore, Chamarajanagara, Bangalore Central and Kolar constituencies. Belgaum, Bagalkot, Koppal, Bellary, Haveri, Uttara Kannada, Davanagere, Shimoga, Udupi, Bangalore North, Bangalore South and Chikkaballapura will be won by BJP. Third Front may win in Hassan, Tumkur, Mandya and Bangalore Rural.
